MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PORT OF EPHRATA COMMISSIONERS June 3, 2024

The Board of Commissioners for the Port District No. 9 of Grant County met in regular session on June 3, 2024 in the Port conference room. Commissioner Nicholas Moore called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

MINUTES: MOTION CARRIED unanimously to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on May 20, 2024 (M/S: Mary M. Rathbone / Shelly Rivard Detrick).

OLD BUSINESS:

<u>Lease Security Consideration Worksheet re: Building 1:</u> The Commissioners discussed the need to increase the minimum amount of security deposit required from only one-month up to three to six months on all future tenants. For this current tenant who has been here for several years and has been in good standing, they agree to continue only requiring one-month rental amount as a security deposit. MOTION CARRIED unanimously to set the new security deposit on Stoneway Electric, LLC's lease on building 1 to \$22,847.28 which is one month of their rental amount (M/S Shelly Rivard Detrick / Mary M. Rathbone).

<u>Jet-A Contractor RFP timing/process:</u> The commissioners had discussed the grading and drainage plans i.e. 99% Review Set dated 06/03/2024 developed by Precision Approach Engineering, Project Manager for the Jet-A Fuel Tank Farm project, that Director Lanman presented to them. The Port is waiting for the City to sign off on these final plans for the Jet-A tank installation. Once the Port receives the sign off, anticipated to be within a few days, the next phase of the project will be implemented i.e. the RFP for contractors. The process should take two weeks once the RFP has been issued.

More discussions were had regarding the sales figures to date of Jet-A along with what additional items that may be needed to add to the pilot's lounge, like a new laptop, or tablet, so that pilots can submit their flight plans.
