<u>Jet-A Fuel Tank Project – Update:</u> The project is moving forward. We have received the permit from the city and all clear from the fire department. The opening of the contractor bids will be this week on July 18<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 pm here at the Port office. The Project is still scheduled to start in August and the tank is ready to be delivered in August as well.

<u>Building 4 Roofing/Siding Project – Update:</u> Director Lanman is working with MRSC to make sure we are following the new bidding and small works roster requirements that went into effect on July 1, 2024.
