MOTION CARRIED unanimously to approve Work Order 24-02 with Ardurra for Runway 3-21 and Taxiway A Rehabilitation (M/S Shelly Rivard Detrick / Mary M. Rathbone).

<u>Track Inspection Report (Coast Rail):</u> Director Lanman spent two hours on Friday walking the entire track with the inspector from Coast Rail. Overall, the rail track is in good condition with only minor repairs needed. Track Assessment Report due by December 4th.

<u>Building 405 Roof Replacement – Discussion:</u> Building 405 has been leaking again and the Port has learned about a new formula that can be used to coat the existing roof without having to replace the entire roof. Frontier Roofing, the contractor used to repair previous leaks, is estimating that they can repair the existing membrane roof for about a third of the cost to replace. The Port is in the process of developing a Scope of Work so that the project can go out to bid.

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>Property Insurance – Notice of Intent to Terminate from CIAW:</u> Director Lanman has sent this notice in so that we can start shopping around for other options next year. The one (1) year notice is a CIAW requirement. Both commissioners Rivard Detrick and Rathbone would need to abstain from any decisions regarding CIAW. The By-Laws will be checked to see what action would need to be taken if we do not have a quorum needed to vote on an action.

PUBLIC/TENANT INPUT: Garett Clemetson informs the commissioners that he might know of someone who would be able to put a bid in for the building 405 roof repairs. It was explained to him that if so, any recommended contractor would have to follow requirements per RCW via a RFP (Request For Proposal) process.
